**ORDER**

On April 5, 2007, John Logan ("Claimant") filed a Request for Administrative Hearing with the Public School Employees' Retirement Board ("Board") requesting that the Board overturn the Public School Employees' Retirement System's ("PSERS") decision, denying Claimant's request to honor the Nomination of Beneficiaries form dated May 1, 2006, naming John W. Logan and Erica A. Frankel as beneficiaries of the Account of Elaine Goodyear ("Decedent") with distribution of 90% and 10%, respectively, because the Nomination of Beneficiary form dated May 1, 2006, was filed with the Board after the date of death of the Decedent.

On April 17, 2007, the Public School Employees' Retirement System ("PSERS") filed its Answer to Claimant's request.

On July 20, 2007, Erica Frankel ("Intervenor") filed a Petition to Intervene in the above-entitled matter.

On August 10, 2007, the Board issued an Order granting the Petition to Intervene.

On December 19, 2007, an Administrative Hearing was held before Hearing Examiner Edward S. Finkelstein.

Based upon the testimony provided at the Administrative Hearing on December 19, 2007, Claimant and Intervenor have entered into a Stipulation and Agreement of Facts (Attachment A).

The Claimant and Intervenor stipulate that Decedent made every reasonable effort under the circumstances to comply with PSERS' requirements to file the Nomination of Beneficiaries form dated May 1, 2006, prior to her death.


The Claimant and Intervenor request that the Board give full force and effect to the Nomination of Beneficiaries form dated May 1, 2006.

PSERS does not object to the Stipulation and Agreement of Facts (Attachment B).

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Claimant's request to honor the Nomination of Beneficiaries form dated May 1, 2006, is hereby GRANTED.
