ORDER

On October 6, 2009, Frank E. Basehoar, Jr. ("Claimant") filed an Appeal and Request for Administrative Hearing with the Public School Employees' Retirement System ("PSERS"). Claimant is appealing service adjustments made to his account regarding a purchase of service.

On October 26, 2009, PSERS filed its Answer to the Claimant's Appeal and Request for Administrative Hearing.


On June 30, 2010, an Administrative Hearing was held before Hearing Examiner Debra K. Wallet.

After reviewing additional evidence, PSERS has agreed to grant Claimant's request, remove the service adjustments made to his account, and provide him the annuity amount that he would have received without the service adjustment.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that because Claimant has been granted his request, his Appeal and Request for Administrative Hearing is deemed MOOT and this matter is hereby DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.
