Stacey Connors serves as Chief Counsel to Senator Pat Browne, Majority Chairman of the PA Senate Appropriations Committee. Stacey has served as Senator Browne's designee on the Public School Employees Retirement System since 2009, and also served as Senator Browne's designee on the Public Employee Retirement Commission (PERC).

In her role as Chief Counsel to Senator Browne, Stacey has been involved in the drafting of significant legislation, including pension reform legislation, the creation of the Independent Fiscal Office to monitor state spending and the budget process, and the Neighborhood Improvement Zone (NIZ), which provided for a tax financing program to revitalize the then-struggling city of Allentown, which has been used as a model for economic development in other areas.

Before joining Senator Browne's staff upon his election to the Senate in 2005, Stacey previously served as Counsel to three former Pennsylvania State Senators: Counsel/Legislative Director to Senator Bob Regola, Chief Counsel/Executive Director of the Senate Urban Affairs and Housing Committee to Senator Charlie Dent, and Counsel/Executive Director of the Senate Urban Affairs and Housing Committee to Senator Joe Uliana. Prior to the Senate, Stacey was an Associate with a Harrisburg general practice law office, and served as Judicial Clerk to the Honorable Paul Allison, Lancaster County Court of Common Pleas.

A graduate of Penn State University (B.A., Pre-Law) and Widener University School of Law (J.D.), Stacey was also elected in November, 2017 as a Township Supervisor in West Hanover Township, Dauphin County.
