

Addendum to:

PSERS HOP Invitation for Application (IFA) 2021-01

This addendum provides the following two updates to the IFA 2021-01:

1. In consideration of the possible Open Enrollment for the 2022 Health Options Program Plan year (as mentioned in the cover letter dated April 8, 2021), attached is summary data for the potential members who may be eligible for the Health Options Program but are not currently enrolled (Appendices F & G to Part I). Please note, this data may include members who have not yet retired, but will be eligible for the program upon retirement.

PSERS will confirm the intent to hold Open Enrollment in early June. To the extent that this decision affects any materials previously submitted for the IFA, consideration will be given to allow for revisions to those materials.
